

SE Uplift Land Use and Transportation Committee

February 16, 2015 Meeting Notes

Meeting began at 7:00pm

1. RICAP 7

Morgan Tracey from the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability updated the committee on the Regulatory Improvement Code Amendment Package 7 (RICAP 7). This year's update included minor code changes including 45 items. Morgan walked the committee through the proposed items that could potentially impact neighborhoods including items 2, 5,6,16,17,18,42, and 27.

2. Mixed Use Zoning Project

Barry Manning from the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability briefed the committee on the Mixed Use Zones project. The project is looking at refining the zoning code for all commercial areas outside of the central city. Looking at reducing the number of commercial zones to four: small, medium, large and EX. Considering allowing bonuses in density in exchange for things of community value like affordable housing and green features. Looking at having a PSC hearing in mid-July.

3. Review of Neighborhood Association Comprehensive Plan Testimony

Bob Kellett provided an overview of the testimony the neighborhood associations within the coalition have submitted. The SE Uplift board is interested in submitting testimony and will use this as the basis for what it submits.

4. Transportation System Plan Projects List

The committee reviewed the proposed projects for the coalition within the Transportation System Plan. The committee did not prioritize the list.

5. NE Halsey Reconfiguration

Terry Dublinski-Milton presented a proposal to modify the roadway on NE Halsey between 68th and 74th to accommodate bicycles. The committee agreed to recommend that the SE Uplift board discuss the proposal at its meeting next month.
