Background: Portland's aging downtown bridges are not expected to withstand a major earthquake. Burnside Bridge is a Regional Emergency Transportation Route and nearing the end of its lifespan. The [Earthquake Ready Burnside Bridge Project](#) will create a bridge able to withstand the looming Cascadia Subduction Zone earthquake. The bridge will provide safer multi-modal connections and provide a critical role in disaster response.
