#### **7:10 p.m. Housing Needs Analysis (HNA) and Housing Production Strategy (HPS)**

**Background:** The Housing Needs Analysis complies with Oregon Planning Goal 10 and informs the Housing Production Strategy being developed to achieve enough housing units for our expected growth. The Portland Bureau of Planning & Sustainability inventories “buildable lands” to make sure there is enough zoned land for housing needs up through 2045. The analysis shows the need for more affordable, family-size, age-friendly, and accessible homes. There is also the need for more opportunities for home ownership.

**Purpose:** Join us in understanding how the number of housing units is determined and the considerations to provide enough housing for all members of the community. Share your perspective as residents of southeast Portland and learn how to provide comment.

#### **8:00 p.m. 2023 Regional Transportation Plan**

**Background:** People in our region use the transportation system to meet up with family and friends, travel to school, work, and recreation. Metro is working to provide more options for how people and goods get around safely and on time. The 2023 Regional Transportation Plan lays out investment priorities for the next 20 years in the Portland region. This covers transit, sidewalks, bridges, bikeways, and roads along with road maintenance and upkeep. All projects submitted by local agencies should

come from adopted plans or strategies that had opportunity for public input. The 2023 Regional Transportation Plan must be completed by December 6, 2023 and adopted by [Metro Council](#).
