7:30 **Make Powell Crossing of 70s Neighborhood Greenway Safe for All**

Background: The [70s Neighborhood Greenway](#) spans six miles, providing a north-south biking and walking route from SE Flavel Street to NE Sacramento within District 3. Notable improvements include enhanced crossing treatments at busy, speed bumps and wayfinding on low traffic streets. While the project is largely complete, there remains a critical gap at the crossing of Powell Blvd and 79th Ave, between the Foster-Powell and South Tabor neighborhoods.

Status: TriMet is designing this key crossing within Oregon Department of Transportation constraints. Powell Blvd west of I-205 and at the crossing is a high-crash, arterial roadway maintained by Oregon Department of Transportation. The proposed crossing fails to provide safety for people walking and biking.

Purpose: Oregon Walks, BikeLoud, and APANO are [advocating for a safe and usable crossing](#) at this key location. The Land Use & Transportation Committee is being asked to issue a recommendation to the SE Uplift Board on a safe crossing for all.
